## Measures we're taking

How we're ensuring workers know how to keep themselves safe from exposure to COVID-19

- By recommending masking at all times in the hall.
- By following the double vaccination mandate.  
Screening Individuals that enter the facility
- By Tracking all who enter the facility. (Sign in sheet)
- Social distancing and Masking
- Plexiglass at bar
- Daily sanitizing of surfaces and touch points

How we're screening for COVID-19

- Symptom screening at the entrance
- Anyone answering Yes will be denied entry and asked to contact the health unit.

How we're controlling the risk of transmission in our workplace

### Physical distancing and separation

- Taping on floor to show proper distancing at the Bar area
- Distancing Signage throughout the building and hallways
- Tables of 4 and 8 will be set up in the hall to ensure distancing while socializing is provided.

## Cleaning

Touchpoints will be cleaned daily

Sanitizer will be placed on each table in the hall, on the bar, in the ice barn and in the bathroom.

## What we will do if there is a potential case, or suspected exposure to, COVID-19 at our workplace

- Report any case or suspected case to the local Health Unit (Renfrew County Health Unit-Pembroke)
- Provide the Tracking sheet to the health unit showing all those who may have been exposed. Provide contact information for those at risk.
- Close the centre until it can be completely cleaned.

## How we're managing any new risks caused by the changes made to the way we operate our business

- We are evolving with any changes in the regulations and working with the local health authority.

## How we're making sure our plan is working

- All convenors and members will be asked to report on how our centre is doing as it pertains to being a safe and compliant space. We welcome reports of non compliance.
- We will modify protocol to ensure compliance.
